Harmful (European Definition)

Harmful by inhalation, in contact with skin and if swallowed. Irritating to eyes, respiratory system and skin.

In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advise.

Wear suitable protective clothing.

Do not breathe dust.

## SECTION IV - FIRST-AID MEASURES

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes.

If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen.

If swallowed, wash out mouth with water provided person is conscious. Call a Physician.

Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

## SECTION V - FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguishing Media: Water spray; Carbon dioxide, dry chemical powder or appropriate foam.

Special firefighting procedures: Wear self-contained breathing apparatus and protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes.

Unusual fire and explosions hazards: Emits toxic fumes under fire conditions.

Wear respirator, chemical safety goggles, rubber boots and heavy rubber gloves.

Sweep up, place in a bag and hold for waste disposal.

Avoid raising dust.
